

INDIANA WING ENCAMPMENT PACKING LIST

ABU/OCP

1 ABU or OCP Shirt with all required insignia (2 preferred)
1 pair ABU or OCP Pants (2 preferred)
1 ABU or OCP cap
1 ABU or OCP belt
7 tan or Coyote Brown t-shirts
7 pair of black, sage green, or coyote brown boot socks
1 set boot blousing strands
1 pair of black or coyote brown Combat boots (well broken in)
1 set grade insignia

12" Ruler
Pocket size Notebook and pen or pencil
1 Pair small scissors
Lint Roller
Bed Sheets & pillow along with a blanket - XL twin sheet set that can be purchased from Wal-Mart/Target or Amazon. Bedding should be of a solid color

ITEMS YOU MAY BRING

Robe
Hand soap
Travel iron
Conservative make-up for females (For graduation)

BLUES UNIFORM

1 short sleeve Blues uniform shirt/blouse
1 pair Blues uniform pants/skirt
1 blues belt (blue belt with nickel buckle)
1 flight cap with proper insignia
1 pair of black low quarter (or pumps for females) uniform shoes
3 pair of black dress socks
3 white v-neck t-shirts
2 - 4 Shirt Stays (garters) Optional

Physical Training Uniform

1 pair of athletic shoes
4 pairs of conservative black athletic shorts, hemmed (No cutoffs or bike shorts)
7 pair of athletic socks

EXTRA CLOTHING ITEMS

Clothes to travel in (CADETS MUST REPORT IN UNIFORM)
1 ANSI Class 2 safety vest or PT belt
One piece swimsuit for females and swim trunks for males (No bikinis or male swim briefs)

PERSONAL HYGIENE ITEMS

Shower shoes
Personal hygiene items (deodorant, shaving supplies, comb, soap, shampoo, toothbrush & paste, etc.)
2 Shower towels, 2 hand towels, 2 washcloths
Comb/Brush (if needed)
1 Package of Moleskin for blisters
Foot Powder
Band-Aids
Sun Block (50 SPF or higher)
Bug Repellant
Any other personal hygiene items needed

MISCELLANEOUS

9 pairs of undergarments
1 Mesh Laundry Bag (marked with first and last name) 1 clear poncho
6 matching clothes hangers
Shoe shine kit
Flashlight (small) w/extra batteries
Current CAP Membership Card

CONTRABAND

DO NOT BRING THESE ITEMS

- Knives
- Weapons or firearms of any type.
- Alarm clocks
- Alcohol or tobacco products
- Electronic devices - including smart watches
- Cell Phones
- Non-CAP reading material (religious acceptable)
- Lighters, matches, or other dangerous items
- Curling irons, hot rollers
- Valuable items/jewelry
- Any item not conducive to the encampment environment, as judged by the Executive Staff

A FEW COMMENTS AND REMINDERS

- All gear will be searched during in-processing and contraband will be confiscated. Items will be returned at the end of encampment unless the item is illegal.
- ALL MEDICATION MUST BE SENT IN ORIGINAL CONTAINERS AND MUST BE LISTED IN CAP HEALTH
- Please be sure to mark all property and clothing with both first and last name
- Do not count on being able to purchase items during encampment at all
- The staff assumes no responsibility for lost, misplaced, or stolen items during the course of Encampment.
- Only Squadron First Sergeants are authorized to wear the diamond on their insignia
- Students DO NOT wear ribbons or cords, but badges are optional. Cadre MUST wear ribbons, with badges optional, and CAC cords optional (region and above ONLY).
- Water bottle and/or canteen, holder and pistol belt
